

## Nursing Program Petition Process

Students gain entrance into the Nursing Program at Nicolet by petitioning to take the HESI A2 Exam.

## REQUIREMENTS TO PETITION and be eligible to take the HESI A2 Exam:

- Completion of admission requirements to Nicolet College as a nursing student.
- Successful completion of two semesters of high school chemistry with grades of "C" or better or one semester of college chemistry with grade of "C" or better.
- Successful completion of the nursing assistant course or verification of completion of the nursing assistant course. (Typically must submit an acceptable Wisconsin Criminal/Caregiver Background Check during this process).
- Successful completion of General Anatomy & Physiology with a grade of "C" or better.
- Must have a 2.0 cumulative grade point average.
- Completion of online Nursing Petition Process module. Your Success Coach will enroll you in the module in Brightspace.

Here are the details of how program placement works:

- Students will be accepted in order of their HESI A2 exam score and clinical availability. Typically we take 20-25 students into the program every fall semester. The exact number of students depends on clinical space.
- Students will be notified approximately 3 weeks after the HESI A2 exam of their placement into the program. HESI A2 is typically offered once a year in June. Every other year we typically offer a HESI A2 in August.

- Biology
- Chemistry
- Anatomy & Physiology
- Math
